New In-Person School Information

NEW SCHEDULE:

ALL students will be on our <u>new schedule</u> and PLEASE NOTE THAT OUR SCHOOL DAY NOW STARTS AT **8:30 AM**, for both in-person **AND** remote students!

PARKING:

When we are all back in school, parking will be very tight! Students are reminded of the following:

- WHS student lot is first come first served
- Vehicles cannot park in the turn around circles, hash-marked areas or any other non-designated area
- Students are not to park in visitor spots, staff spots or the bus cutouts
- Students may not park in the neighborhoods behind the school as all are restricted to permit parking only, and that is strictly enforced
- Students cannot park in the Jenks Lot across from the Town Hall
- Students cannot park in the Stop and Shop parking
- Violators are subject to having their vehicles towed
- Please be good neighbors and only park in student parking
- Students are encouraged to walk, bike, or get a ride to school

FREE BREAKFAST AND LUNCH:

Did you know that the USDA has approves **FREE** breakfast and lunch for **ALL** students for schools on the National School Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program for the rest of the school year! This means that **ALL** students will have access to nutritious meals at **NO COST** to parents.

Meals are approved to be served both **IN PERSON** and for **PICK UP**. Students attending school in person are eligible to pick up breakfast and lunch daily at **NO CHARGE** (1 breakfast and 1 lunch).

WHS COVID-19 Pool Testing Sign-Up

89% of WHS students did NOT participate in pooled testing last week. The pilot needs many more students registered and coming in weekly to test in order to make COVID-19 surveillance testing at WHS successful. It's so easy - we just need your nose! The whole process takes 2 minutes and you can get the peace of mind of being COVID free (at the time of the test).

An 11% student participation rate is low compared to other high schools in the state. WHS leads - let's live up our rep!
