- 3. Each WHS student must be signed in by his/her parent or guardian. The WHS parent is responsible for the guest.
- 4. WHS dining commons will open at 7:00 PM and close at 7:30 PM sharp.
- 5. Students/Guests will not be allowed to reenter the dance.
- 6. Students are not allowed to leave until 9:00 pm unless picked up by a parent.
- 7. Students must be present in school for each class the day of the dance.
