High School VOTER Registration Week is September 21-25.

The registration deadline is **Saturday**, **October 24th** for online and in-person. Mail-in must be **postmarked** by Oct. 24th.

Please take time to register to vote or check your registration status if you think you were automatically registered through the RMV or registered or pre-registered at a past League of Voter vote registration event.

If you are 18 or turning 18 on or before November 3rd, you are eligible to vote. Go to www.vote411.org to check your registration status and learn about the ballot initiatives.

To register online, you must have either a Drivers License or the last 4 digits of your Social Security number to complete the form.

Students without a Drivers License of SS number will need to provide identification as listed on the registration form under "Identification to be Provided." The paper form must be accurately filled out in **pen** and mailed to Town Hall, 71 Mt. Vernon St., Winchester, MA 01890, Attn: Town Clerk. Currently, the Town Hall is closed to the public. You can call the Town Clerk at 781-721-7130 to set up an in-person appointment, if necessary.

Flu Clinic Time!

The Winchester Health Department in collaboration with the School District, is pleased to again offer flu clinics at every school this fall.

- On-line registration is available NOW!
- Go to: <u>www.winchester.us</u> and click on the school flu vaccination icon.
- · Registration will end on September 25th .

At the on-line registration site, you will find the information you need to sign your child up for either the FluMist nasal spray or flu shot. If you have a question after reviewing the information, please contact the Health Department at healthdept@winchester.us.

NOTE: The clinics are voluntary; however, Massachusetts now requires that all students Pre-School -12, receive a flu vaccination by December 31st. The new vaccine requirement is an important step to reduce flu-related illness and the overall impact of respiratory illness during the COVID-19 pandemic. We encourage you to enroll your child.
